A friend of mine told me to keep making chess sets because she did not see anyone doing the same. I enjoy making chars sets because they take so long, the possible new innovations are limited only by my imagination, and making something for physical use is valuable to my creative process. There is an increased level of relational capacity as I build, Finish, and pass the chess set along. There are ample opportunities to barder and trade for additional building supplies. A percentage of the profit goes to a selected chairty. Finally, true stories are created to remember, share, entertain and even amaze. I am continually amazed. "Chess set Number Three "is made from Baby Pander (Corn Starch & Sodium Bicarbonate), glue, acrylic mediums, popsicle sticles, chip board, acrylic paint, and Cotton Canuas. I sketched, sculpted, moulded, and cast the chess pieces. Then I detailed them with paint. This chess set took 15 months, 728 hrs., and 448.63 to create. It also required grace and support of the community where I live.
